IHF TRACKING DOG WORLD CHAMPIONSHIP 2010

Place: Ystad – Sjöbo area in south Sweden

Date: September 24 - 26 / 2010 (welcome ceremony in evening September 24)

Judges: Mr. Göran Wessman Sweden
Mrs.Frauke Ortmann Germany

Competition: The competitor shall in two following days carry out two different tracks,

judged by two different judges. The tracks correspond to international rules for IPO-FH2: distance app. 2000 steps (1500 meter), 7-9 angles from which 2 shall be point angles and 1 bow turn with a diameter of app. 50 steps.

Age of the track is 180 minutes, and tracking time is 40 minutes.

The track contains 7 objects of wood, textile and leather; from which 1 is

an identification object.

A 30 minute old deceive track crosses the main track at 2-3 places.

Terrain: Open fields in costal- and forest areas.

Participants: The number of participants is limited to 10 according to IHF standards.

First priority is that each IHF-country will have the possibility to participate

with 1 dog, and remaining places will be disposed by lottery.

Entry: procedure

Enclosed entry form shall be used, and all inquired information must be filled in. IHF countries that like to make application for more than one participant must use separate entry forms for each participant, and clearly

state which one of the participants is 1:st choice, 2:nd choice etc.

NOTE: Application for entry should not be made by individual persons, but

by representative for the Hovawart Clubs in the countries.

Lot drawing: In case of remaining places after entry time has expired, these will be

disposed by lottery. The first lottery will include all 2:nd choice dogs, and in case of still remaining places the same procedure will be carried out

with the 3:rd choice dogs etc.

Qualifications: Each IHF country is independently organizing this procedure.

Application: Application fee is SEK 300 for each participant.

NOTE: The fee should not be paid until possible lottery has been

accomplished. Further information regarding procedures for entry fees and

booking meals etc. will follow.
